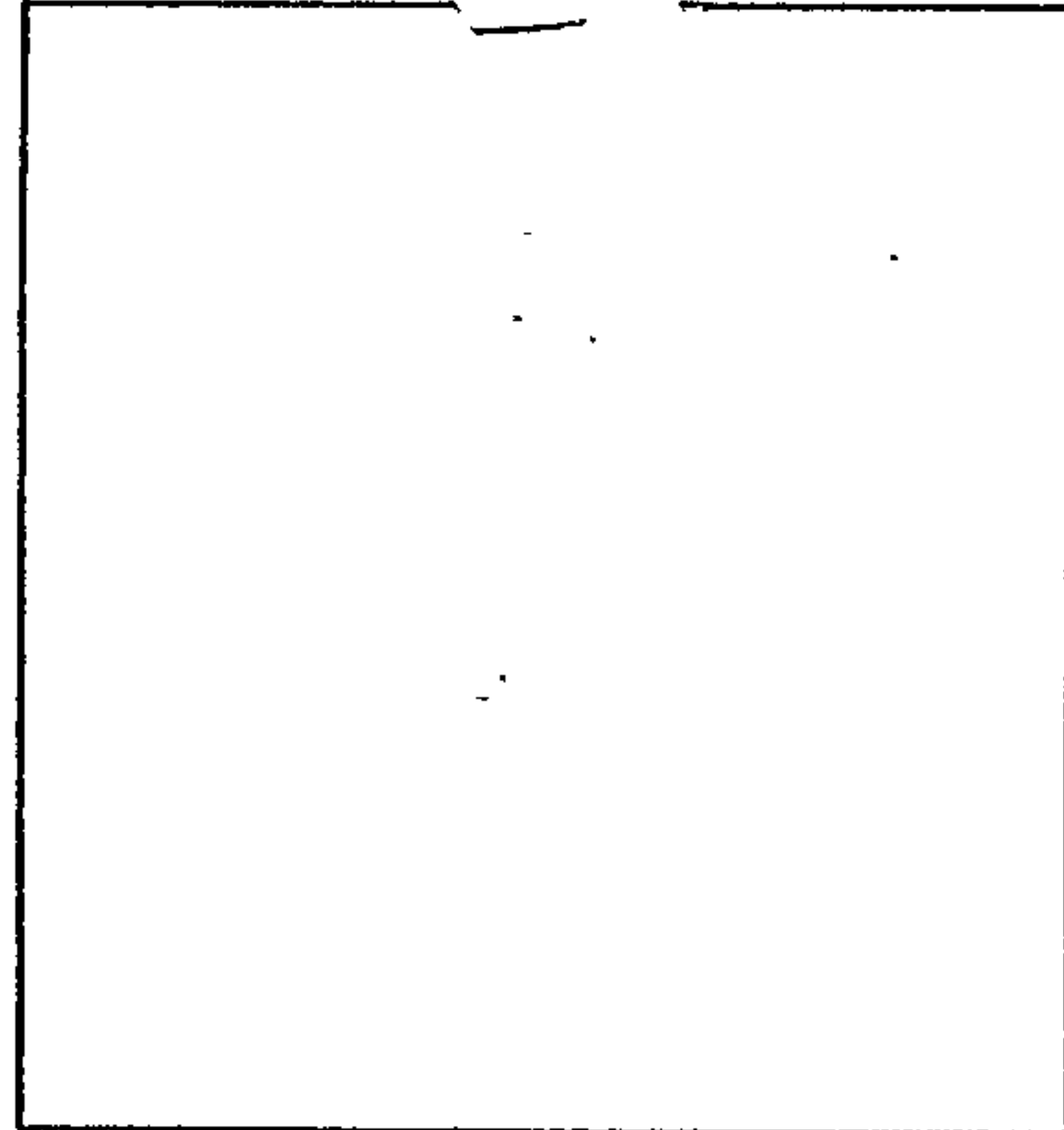

On Sept. 1982 the missionary came to our Church. It was at his invitation for anyone to surrender to the "Lord's Ministry I heard God's Call in my soul and walked forward to tell Jesus Here I am Lord use me". I joined the Bible College graduating in 1986. To now I never have doubted God has called me to His service.
