22. Describe a typical daily schedule.

I wake up at 6:00 AM for morning prayers, reading the Bible,
and pray. My wife prepares breakfast and I depart for
work up to 5:00 PM. On arrival at home after 5:00 PM I
take a shower, then supper, fellowship with family, they go
to sleep while I remain to do Bible study after
which I pray and go to sleep around 10:30 PM latest.
We also have prayer meetings on Wednesdays, mid-
week fellowship (church) on Fridays, soulwinning on Saturday
and revival meetings Sunday even after
Sunday services.

23. Describe your wife's typical daily schedule. *Wife wakes up at 6:00 AM Prays after which she prepares breakfast and around 7:30 sees children off to school. Organises her house ^{washes clothes,} fetches water and firewood, cooks lunch, cleans house, holds utensils washes children, prepares supper, assists childrens homework recites bible verses, prays and sleeps.*
24. Do you grow your own food or do you purchase it? *We grow on small scale and this according to size we have and this sustains us for 3 or 4 months and we start buying food the rest of the year.*
