My Personal Testimony

And Call into the ministry.

I was converted to be a christian when I was seriously attacked by certain disease which cost me a lot of money. I went to many doctors both native and medical doctors, none was able to cure me, until one day my spirit told me to meet our neighbouring woman who had been attacked by disease which no man was able to cure her, but God, through prayers and supplication of the saints cured her. To this woman I went and explained my problem. She encouraged me to accept as my personal lord and savior which I did and the sickness was instantly cured. When

the sickness vanished I continued in my christianity. My Senior brother who is my guardian after the death of Parents became annoyed because of my continuation in christianity. He said he felt my purpose of going to another church is because of sickness, now that I am free won't I come out there? I told him that the sickness came for the purpose of my salvation; then this became the beginning of my persecution.

The wife of my brother became an agent of my enemy to persecute me in different ways, no proper attention was giving to me any longer. no food, no cloth, there was no intension to train me in any other work. I am so much neglected more than any other person among us. All these happened after my school career.

Because of this condition I joined my brother's driver. To conduct his vehicle and I did it for 3 years, He agreed to pay A60 a month and decided to keep it for me to avoid waste, I have to agreed what he said and after three years when I stopped the work no money was given to me and no Business was opened for me, then I endured it still. The suffering was still too much that I went to my relations and reported, any person I gave the report will support my brother because I have changed my church.

This sufferings lasted many years before my call.

MY CALL INTO THE MINISTRY.

The Lord Called into the ministry by many proofs. I was called into the ministry in 1988. And I was sent to look after a very young ministry which is not so much able to care for ones life, then knowing this condition I could not depend much on it, but on my family. My people knowing this condition, persuaded me to join a bigger church so that they will be able to cater for me.

To do the will of God is better than will of man. I have to continue with the ministry. But my problem that ~~there~~ was that I have grown up to marry and become a family man, may look at it, no hope both sides, Only God is my hope always, The ministry is not yielding enough as to cater for me and my guardians are not willing to know my ways about. What must I do? Even now I am still facing a lot of difficulty. I pray God to relief me. I know he must do so. Because I know God who began his good work will bring it to the end.
