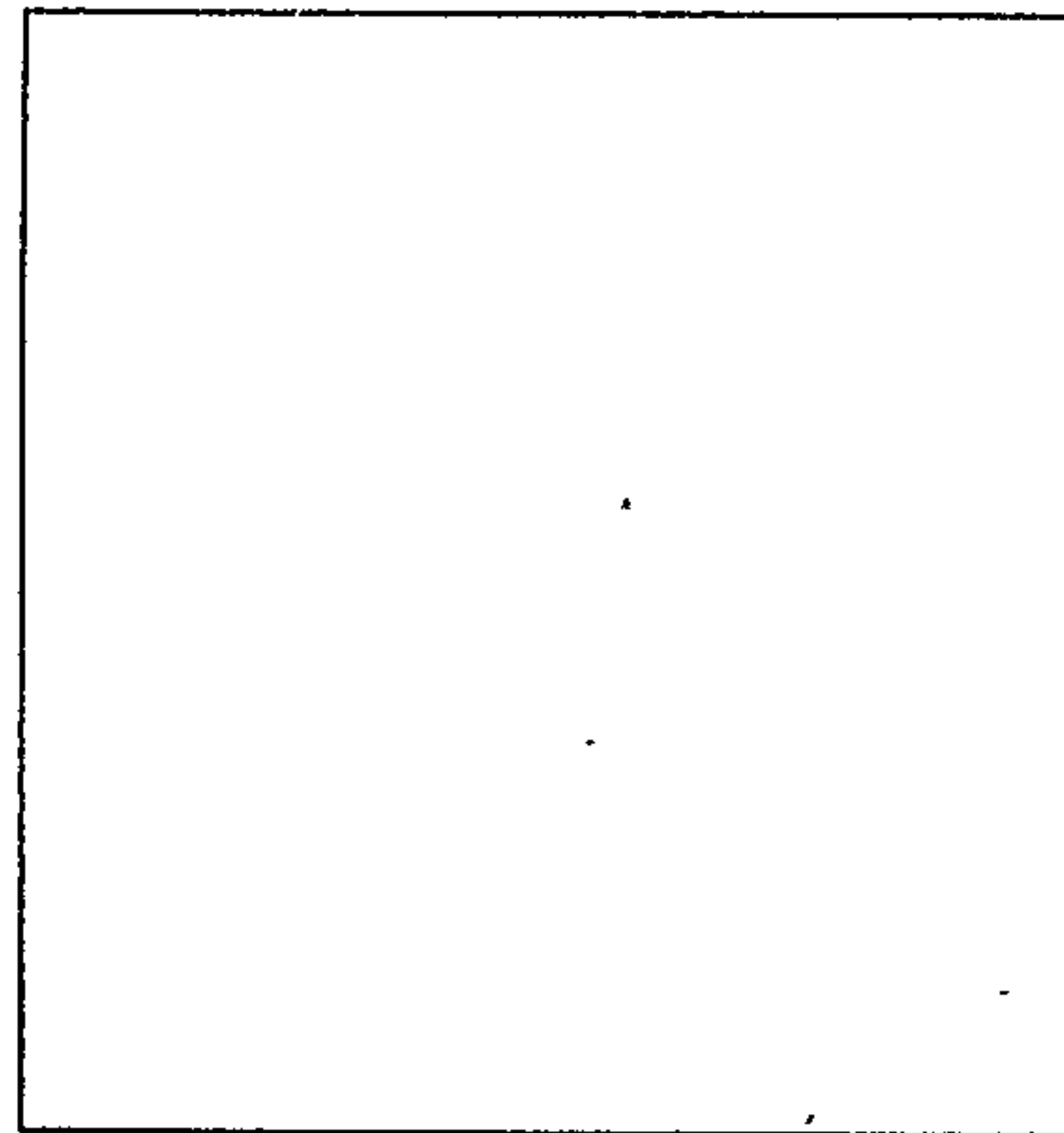

I have more than 35 Adults and 40 children in our Sunday school though we are still using one of our members house as the meeting place. Sometime we worship under the hot sun if the day is fine. Mostly on Friday I do make it a visiting day to old and new members. Sometimes I do walk if the bicycles in problem and I do with all my courage to win souls to Christ.

The only hardship thing is that sometimes I can move on heavy rain fall to and from the church. God willing we are looking for a plot to build the church building please pray for us in Pulwet Baptist church.
