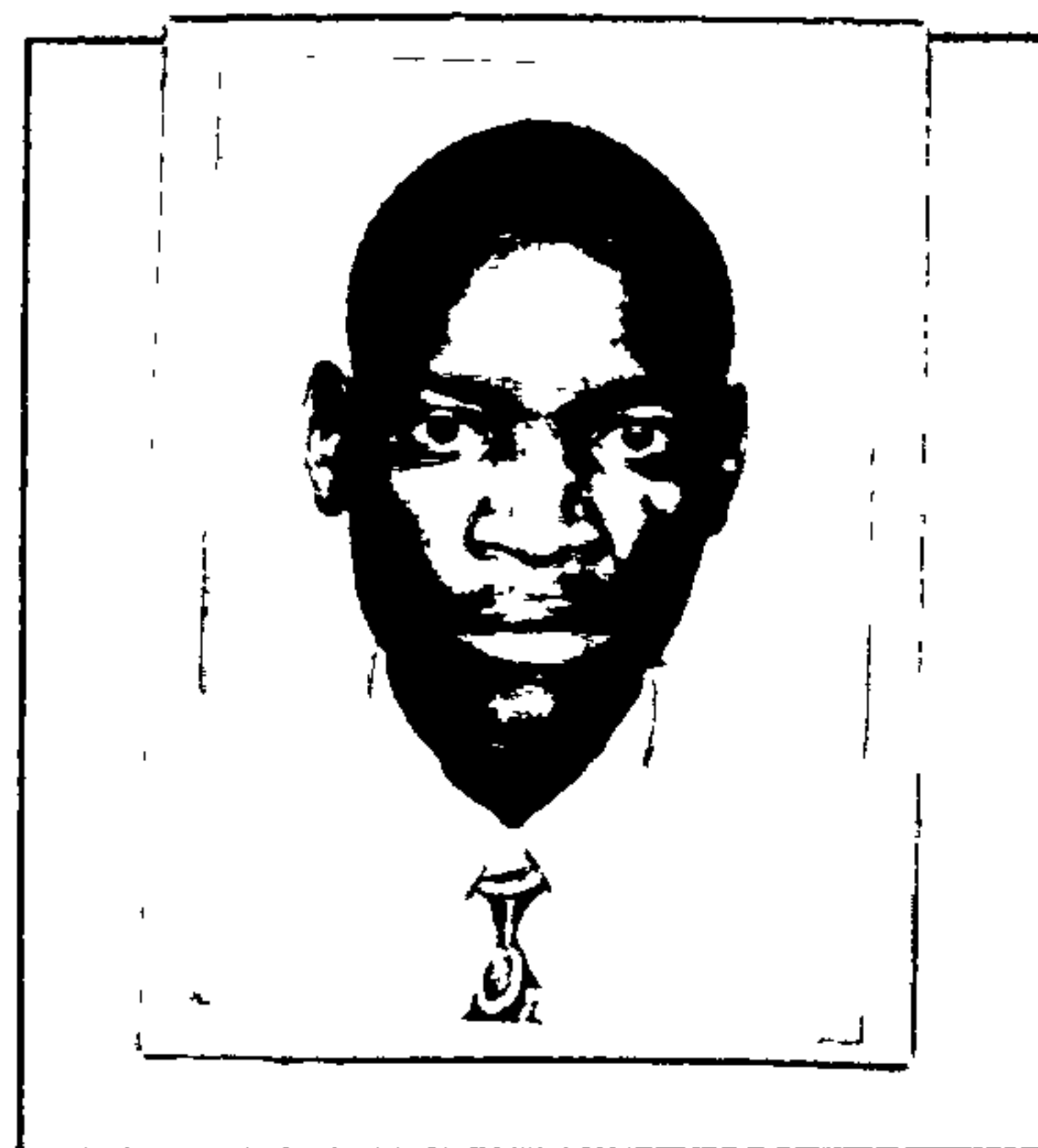
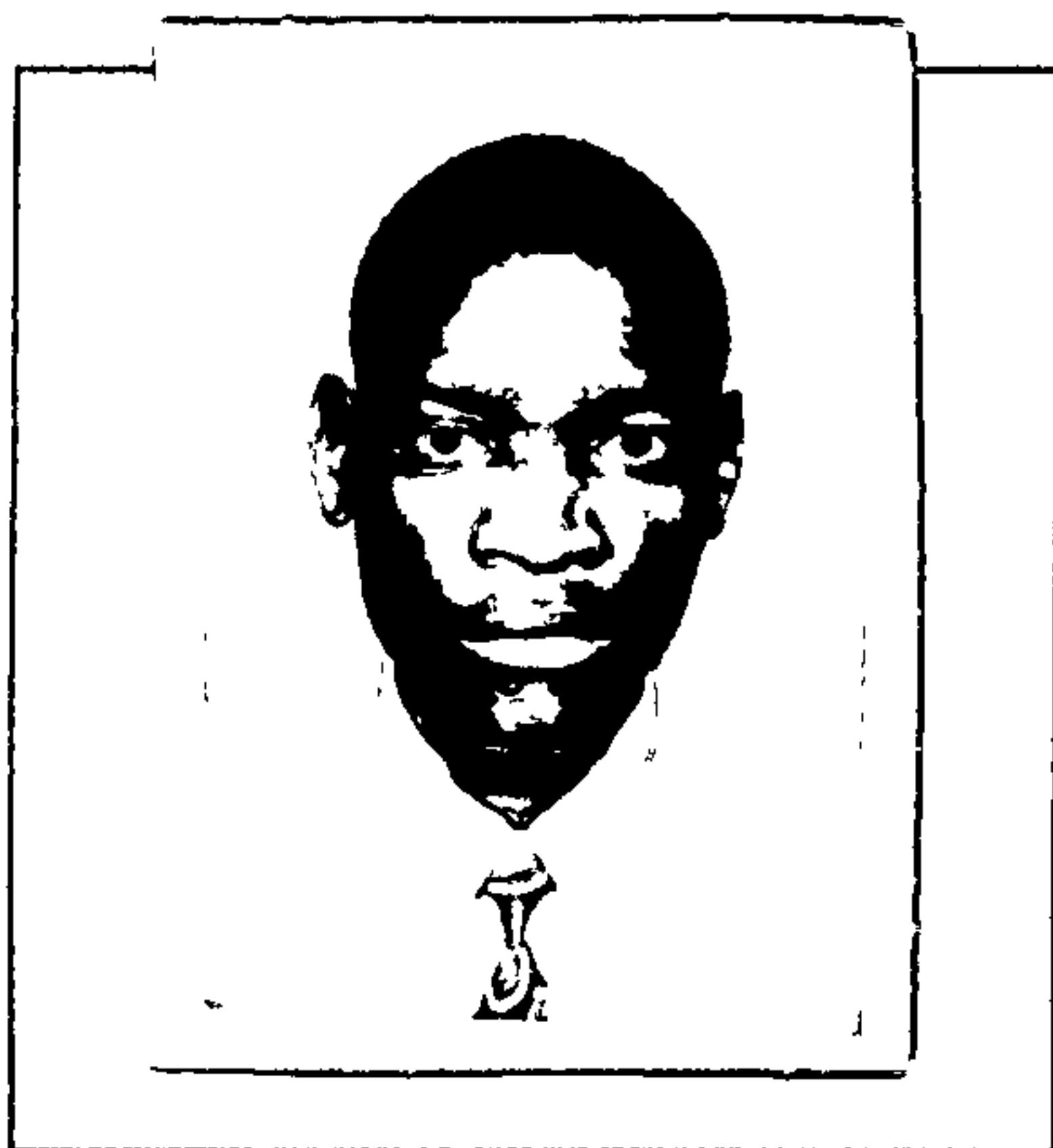

1. Please write a detailed testimony of your salvation, and call to the ministry.

I was saved on the 20th of July 1993 Monday afternoon. The day before, I had heard a very powerful preaching of God's word by Rev. Alute Thomas the then pastor of the Kings BBC. I had never been so much subjected to such strong preaching. I was so much convicted that I saw how wicked I was before a holy God and how I was just a step towards damnation. During the invitation I did not come forward. I went home and come the following day still under conviction, I was led to the saving knowledge of our Lord and Jesus Christ by the pastor's wife who was at the house. I trusted on the Lord Jesus Christ to save me and be the Lord of my life. It was an experience I will never forget because after asking for forgiveness and calling upon Christ to come into my heart, I felt a great peace in my heart that has never been lost - I was saved and I knew it the very moment until today I still know and recall what took place in my heart. This meant to me that I was forgiven, I became a new creature, I was no longer under the penalty of sin, for I knew that I had eternal life from that very day even now and in eternity. After a fortnight, I was scripturally baptised by my pastor. After 3 months my pastor preached from Haggai on 'Misplaced Priorities'. It was after this message that the Lord called me to prepare for the ministry. I was certain of God's calling - to be a pastor after long prayers and verification. I forsook going for a professional course in clearing and forwarding for I had the qualifications and also had received an invitation, but instead joined a Bible College in 1994 to be equipped for the ministry. Theodore Daub - a bible baptist missionary. While there I also worked with the Meru pastors' fellowship until my departure late 2001 - I am now working with the Trans-nzoia pastors' fellowship.

19. Are all your children Christians and have they been baptized? If not, please explain.

Not all are Christians, I am praying for the first-two that they would respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ and be saved, thereafter be baptised. It is my responsibility to lead my children to the saving knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ - pray for them.

At the moment my house (rental) is made of mud, posts, iron sheets on roof, house 8 by 14 feet.
