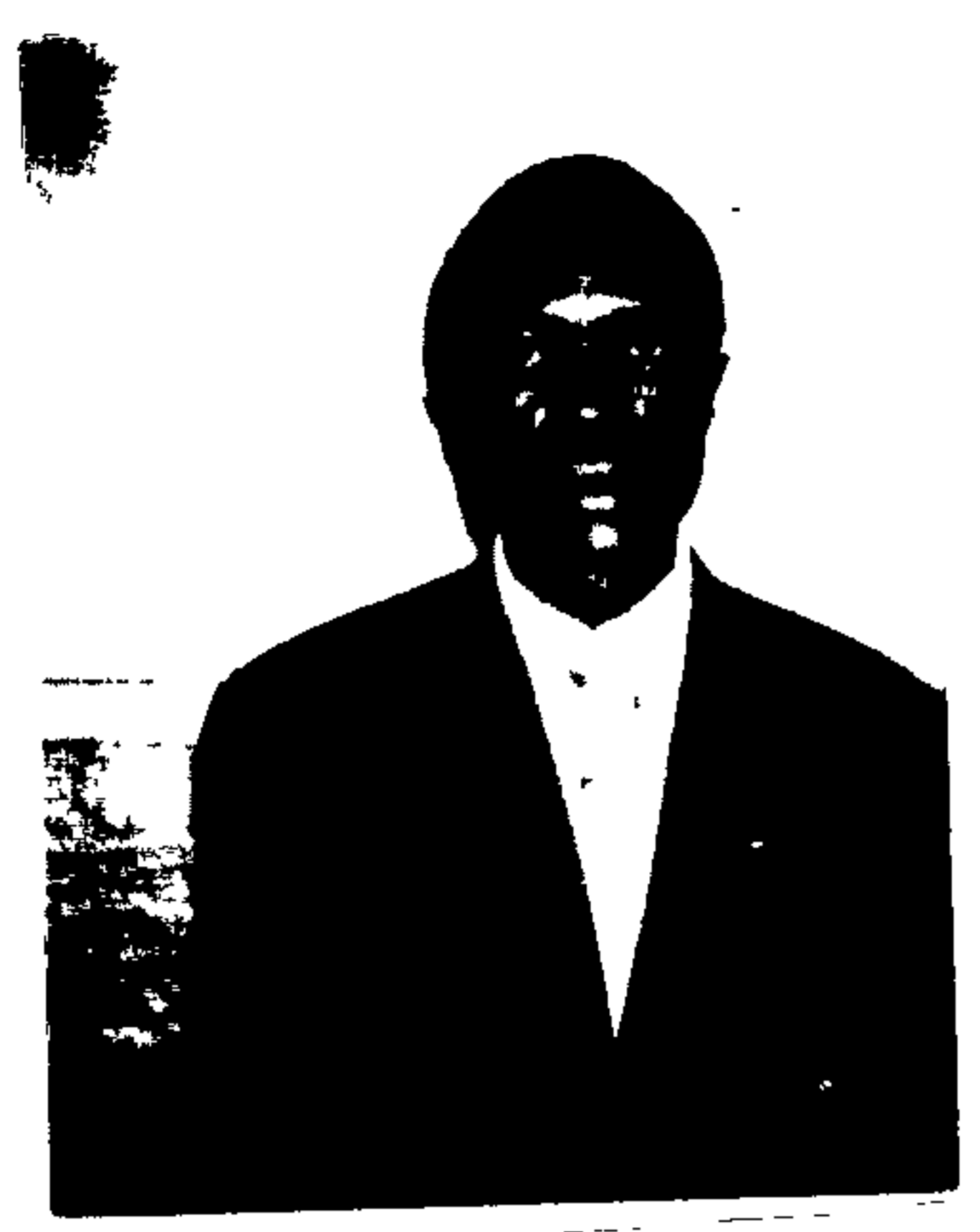

From Bedi she goes for morning devotion with me, then visit prison or hospital with her for preaching, she helps me with singing and giving assurance to those getting saved. In the evening we have Fellowship together with her according to the days on our schedule, Saturday she visit with me.
