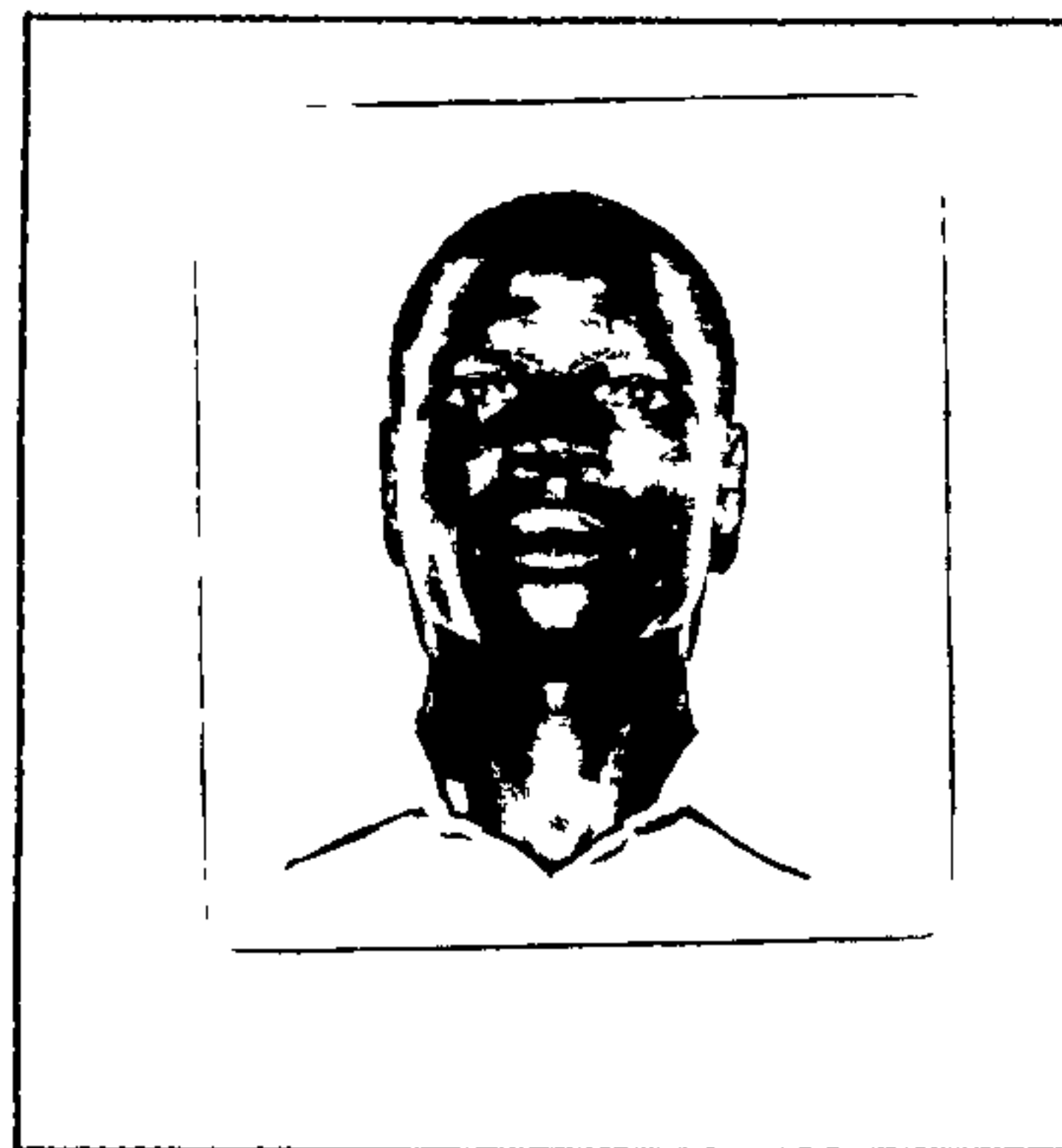
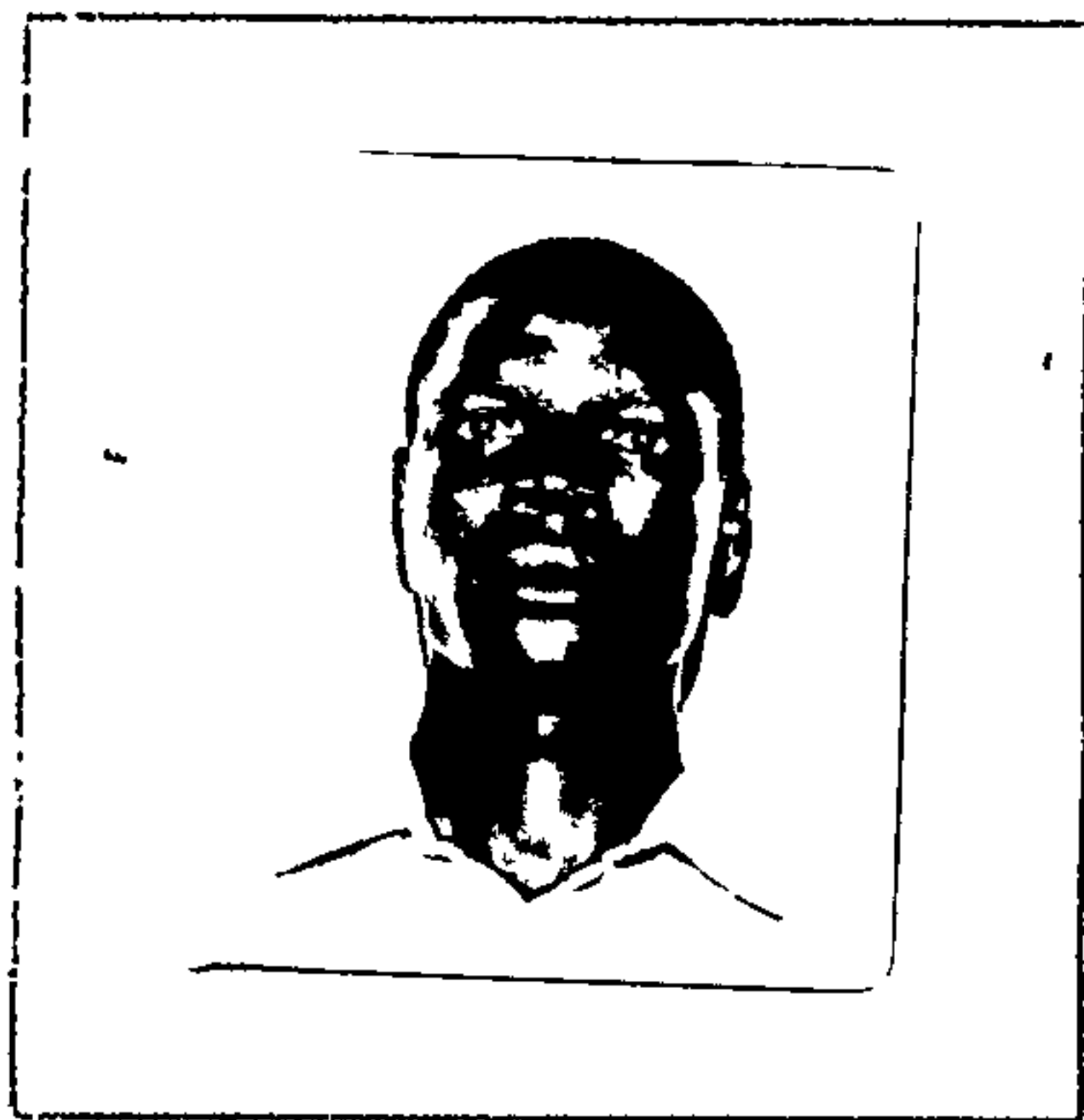

6. DOCTRINAL BASIS:

All members of our ministry believe in the following fundamental Bible doctrines of faith;

6:1 The Genesis account of creation.

6:2 One God, who created all visible and invisible things in the universe. God is one in essence, but He exists eternally in three persons as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

6:3 The Bible both the Old and New Testaments, as divinely inspired, inerrant and infallible Word of God. The Bible is entirely trustworthy, reliable and supreme in authority in all matters of faith and conduct.

6:4 Jesus Christ, as both God and man, He eternally and inseparably exists as one person. We believe in His virgin birth, His sinless human life, His divine miracles, His vicarious and atoning death on the cross, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to heaven, His priestly and mediatorial work in heaven and His promised bodily return to earth. **power**

and glory in unspecified time in the future to take His own unto Himself.

6:5 The Holy Spirit, as the third Person of the Godhead. He is God and He has personality. He is the one who convicts sinners of sin and effects the new birth upon the non-believers. He also indwells and empowers the believers to live and to witness and work for the Lord Jesus Christ.

6:6 The dignity and sanctity of human life; that the life of man, both male and female, should be preserved and clothed with dignity because humans were created in God's image.

6:7 The historical and universal fall of mankind, making every man and woman, sinful and guilty before God and subject to God's wrath and eternal damnation.

6:8 The necessity of the new birth; that each individual human being should be born again in order to have his sin and guilt before God forgiven.
