1 - Please write a detailed testimony of your salvation and call to the ministry.

My name is Peter Mungaya. I was born in a polygamous pagan family at Oldeani in Arusha, Tanzania. This was in 3rd January, 1979. My father had five wives; however one of them passed away. Following the fact that my tribe is in patrilineal system, my father used to treat his wives in a brutally way. Since in my family no one was saved, almost everybody depended on pagan kind of lifestyle. I used to see in our family pagan practices associated with witchcraft such pouring of libation to appease spirits. I found no success in such family. Instead of experiencing success of my parents, I saw a great lost. I found myself living a bad life as a kind of inheritance from my parents.

In the year 2004, I decided to give my life to Jesus. I heard the message of the Gospel through the man who is now the pastor of our mother church. I remember he used the Word from Rom. 3:21-23; Rom. 10:9 - 10 and John 3:16. The word of God touched me. I made a decision to accept Jesus as my personal savior. I was baptized and continued to receive teachings through Sunday School programs in my church.

The call to service came one year later. I started witnessing my parents. In the year 2005, my church declared me as their full time evangelist. Through serving the Lord, I'm seeing His hand. Three of my parents, such as my father and two of his wives accepted Jesus in the year 2007. During this time I am a holder of Certificate of Theology.

I am married with one wife and blessed with two children. My wife's name is Anna. She is saved and we are serving the Lord together.

In my conviction as I remember of my background I came to realize the truth of the Word of God which is the Bible. I believe that Bible is the true message written to God's inspired men. In the morning I wake up and take tea. Then I go to my farm to work at it for 4 hours and come back. In the afternoon after taking lunch I have to do door to door evangelism with my wife or other evangelists. Sometimes I go to nearby market place to do air meets at least for 2 hours two times a week. During the week on Wednesday from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm I have to teach new converts in our church.

- 23 - Describe your wife's typical daily schedule.**

She mainly do home work such as cooking, cleaning and looking for firewood. In the afternoon she joins me in serving the Lord.

I grow my food and buy part of it. But most of the things needed we have to buy.
