My dad became the first Christian school teacher in our village, he took keen interest in educating me up to high school and encouraged me to find a job in the local sugar factory, due to steady income , I did not know how to handle , so I began to indulge in all kinds of sins with my friends, many a times I would pick up a fight on the streets and would land myself in the police station, by the time I got married I had many police cases on me booked, I was supposed to spend my time in jail, if not for the intervention of my dad, who was very respected by the police and other authorities.

One night when I came home after a fight, my dad counseled me and spoke to me from the Bible based on Ecc 11:9 , he made me read the whole chapter on that night, the verses shook me and stirred my heart to know that I was walking in a wrong way. The next day morning a local pastor came to me and counseled me from the scripture, on that morning I wept and confessed my sins to the Lord and believed Jesus paid the penalty for all my sins.

From then on I began to read my Bible daily and attend prayer service regularly, later on I was convinced to obey the Lord in water baptism and began to share my testimony to all of my friends , some of them accepted Jesus as their savior, some rejected but on the whole I was compelled to resign my job at the local factory. Joined Bible college for two year Diploma and from then on I am in the full time ministry.
