On the other hand I witnessed my older brother Kempanna being beaten mercilessly and thrown out of our house, his crime was refusal to bow before the altar of Yellamma goddess because he embraced Christianity.

I could not understand why my brother was enduring such punishment, why he was leading a homeless life when he had a choice for a better living. I thought my brother was crazy to go after Christianity. I would apply all kinds of incense powered on my forehead as a sign of protection from evil. I even spent much part of my leisure around the priest by serving him and looking after his welfare. In spite of my service in the temple, the priest would not respect me nor show any love towards me, rather he would keep on showing my mistakes and would make me do that and this to earn his respect. I was disheartened and finally quit the temple in disgust and shame, that I was good for nothing.

As I was walking back to my house from the priest, I heard my brother Kempanna preaching to a group of people in the corner of a street, I was surprised at his preaching, he was preaching about the Love of Christ, that Jesus came into the world to save sinners, this word attracted me. I instead of going home, I met my brother and decided to spend the night with him, through the midnight I kept asking him several questions about sins and forgiveness and he lovingly answered my questions from the Bible. That night I had a good sleep and peace of mind. The next morning I received Jesus as my Lord and savior and reached home with great hope in Christ, which eluded me for years. I considered all my service to the temple and the priest as dung.

Upon reaching home and I shared my experience in Christ, my parents without any mercy threw me out of the house and told me to suffer like my preacher brother.. On that fateful day I had no where to go, my neighbors would not take me into their house, people in our streets totally boycotted me, would not permit me to talk to their children, would not permit me to drink water from their taps. No body gave me any food to eat for two days. I could not join my brother for I did not know where went, for my survival I worked as a helper at a roadside hotel for about a month. Through God's providence the same people who assisted my brother, offered me a place to stay. I too began to share my testimony on the streets, my dad happened to see me, he was moved by my preaching, came to me hugged me and took me home. The next day my older brother Kempanna also came home and shared the gospel with my parents. They have now been saved. Praise the Lord. Later I joined Satyam Baptist Bible College and completed my two years of training in Church planting.
