#### Testimony of Vishnu Paul Former Priest of goddess Kolapuradhama Temple

I grew up in a Hindu family, devotee of goddess Laxmi and lord Ganesha, these two were my favorite gods, right from childhood days my parents nurtured me to walk according to Vedic and Bagvat gita teachings. I would help my parents in performing pooja by cleaning all pooja tools and the idols, only then they would enter into the room and perform various rituals. I would just sit and watch, as to how they perform, as such I learnt step by step how to perform poojas, thus I was attracting devotees right from my early days.

My grandfather served as a temple priest to goddess Kolapuradhama. My parents kept a close watch over me and guided me to take over the temple priest after the death of my grandfather in accordance to the family tradition, where the "Older son or a Older grandson" should be the heir to temple priesthood. So naturally I was the oldest son grandson in the family and they dedicated me to be the priest at the demise of my grandfather.

#### Being a priest:

So for three years I served as a priest, during this time I fooled many devotees and would rob their money, saying that I had the power to cast out evil spirits. So the devotees would invite me to their house to perform casting out ritual. First I would analyze the kind of fear they were in and would plan accordingly and would fix certain amount as fees, then the devotees would agree and invite me to their house and I would go to their houses during mid night, when no neighbor would be present at that particular house.

I would apply all kinds of turmeric powder all over my body, hold neem leaves and I would hide a lemon under a robe and then scream at the top of my voice, to impress the devotees that I was filled with the Spirit of goddess Kolapuradhama. And would wave my hands in the air and ask them to close their eyes, stating that, the spirit will operate only when you close your eyes, in fear they would close. At that time I would throw a Lemon on to one corner of their house and go on screaming loud at the devil and command the evil to leave the place at once.

After 15 to 20 minutes I would keep moving around the house, then I ask the family members to open their eyes, when they do so. I would pretend to speak in Sanskrit language, when actually I was just murmuring some words which I myself do not know. Then for a while I would close my eyes and speak to the owner of the house asking him to go to a corner of your house and you will find a lemon and bring it to me, when he brings it to me and I show to the devotee and tell them, look this is the lemon on to which your enemies have cast a spell and threw it into your house. And I with the help of goddess kolapuradham able to locate where the evil spirit was hiding in your house. Now you be happy that I set your family free from the clutches of this evil. The family would feel very happy that I set them free and would pay me 30\$ along with a well grown rooster. They would with a smile hand over me the money along with a rooster, which I would take it to my house cook and eat it along with a bottle of liquor. This is how I as a priest was making my living. But never in my duty as priest felt any divine presence I was only deceiving.

# Life in Christ:

One afternoon as I was returning from a similar assignment, I met a co-passenger sitting next to me in the bus who was reading the Bible, I asked him what his job is, he told me that he was a pastor, then I told him that I am temple priest, he then asked me if I knew anything about the love of God. I said no, then he shared the gospel of Jesus Christ as to why He had to come down to this earth, why He died and rose on the third day. The pastors words were so sweet to listen and I took a gospel tract from and began to read and re-read several times all by myself, I even took it the temple and read it.

Then the following month I met the preacher under "Final Frontier" who again spoke to me from Matt 11:28, Lord Jesus Christ calling people with full of sins and struggles, this verse spoke to me and I could not give my heart to Christ immediately, it took me about three months to accept Jesus Christ as my personal savior by confessing my sins and believing in Him. From then I began to experience real peace and happiness, which was nothing compared to my past priest life. I totally stopped going to the temple, my parents would force me to go and open the temple as well go to the devotee's house to bless them. But I told my dad that from now on I

will no longer open the door of the temple nor perform any rituals for any devotees, because I trusted Lord Jesus as my savior and He is the only true God who forgave my sins.

Then my dad along with his brothers beat me up and threw me out of the house, for three long years I did could not lead a normal life, because my uncle and his friends were after me. I took up a job in a Hotel as a server and remained there for three years, at such time the pastor who led me to the Lord would come and pick me for Sunday service. Later on I felt calling for full time ministry and began to help my pastor, at this time I was able to come across my younger sister and led her to the Lord, it was she who went back to my parents house and told them about how I was being used by the Lord Jesus, she told them how his preaching touched my heart and came to realization that it is only Jesus Christ who truly loved me and gave His life for me. Later on my parents came to me, stayed with me and learnt about the precious Love of our Lord Jesus Christ, then I told them, now I am preaching about the Love of God to all the people irrespective of any caste or religion, they wondered about my new found faith. Then my parents understood and felt that I was serving a true and living God unlike in the past where I was only deceiving Hindu devotees as a false priest.

I am so thankful for my pastor who led me to Satyam Baptist Bible College to be trained as a Timothy, please pray for that the Lord will use me to win souls, I am also blessed with Singing talent, I want to sing for His glory. Please do uphold me in your prayers that the Lord will take me back to my native village. My dad cautioned me not to visit my ancestral village with the fear that my uncle will kill me.

Pray that the two villages i.e. Persurampurahobli & Bhamankunte where between 20 to 25 people are attending Sunday service in each village.
